# **Investing for Success**

# Under this agreement for 2020 Leichhardt State School will receive

\$286, 636\*

# This funding will be used to

Improve Preps oral language to have 75% above the baseline by the end of the school year (24% achieving above the baseline in 2019 on entry to Prep)

Improve percentage of Preps to 30% reaching above the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile in Early Start literacy data by the end of Prep

(3.2% in 2019 were above on entry, with 24.1% above at end of Prep)

Increase the proportion of students improving 2 reading levels per term in Year 1 and 2 to 50%

(2019 Year 1s only 25.5% achieved 2 reading gains per term each term.)

#### Our initiatives include

#### **Prioritise Early Oral Language Intervention**

- In 2019 75% of prep failed on entry to Prep Oral Language Screen, this same percentage is expected for the 2020 cohort. By the end of 2019 support services had improved this by 46.4%. We intend to increase this support to have a 50% improvement.
- Provide Oral language support to Prep Yr 2 classrooms to support students with oral language delays

### **Prioritise Literacy skill development**

- Use case management in 5 weekly cycles to support literacy development using the literacy continuum. (Putting FACES on the Data by Lyn Sharratt and Michael Fullan, 2012)
- Continue to develop targeted literacy interventions using our 'Big 6' reading interventions and improved writing formation strategies.
- Provide teaching staff time to unpack English Units and identify robust vocabulary, develop 'bump-it-up walls' in tandem and develop success criteria for lessons.
- Continue to develop opportunities for teachers to 'watch others work' while teaching reading.
